

SHRINKY DINK CUFF BRACELET



1.) Ready your shrink plastic by sanding it w/ sandpaper


2.) Use the whole length of the 11 in side and cut plastic 11 in. x 4 in. wide.




3.) Draw on the rectangle w/ markers or colored pencils.

4.) GRAB a wooden rolling pin to use to heat the plastic over. Heat w/ a heat gun.

This will serve as the
Top of your cuff bracelet

5.) Heat edges and use a
wooden skewer to create
a roll over edge 

6.) Set top of cuff aside,
Grab your cuttle bug
press a skull & cross bones
Shape out of the shrink
plastic using the Provo Craft
skull & crossbones die for the
cuttle bug.

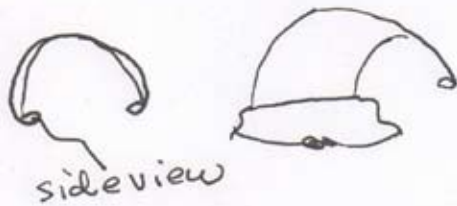
7.) Draw on the skull using
Sharpie markers

8.) Heat w/ a heat gun

9.) Now use your Cutthebug³ Circle die to cut a Black circle about 2 in. out of felt.

10.) Glue the skull to the felt circle & the felt circle to the top of the cuff w/ E6000

11.) Loop a piece of green embroidery floss through the turned over edges @ the bottom of each side of the cuff.



12.) Pull it tight & triple knot it.

13.) Now loop a larger ribbon through the thread. Leave a long tail on both sides.

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Use this ribbon to tie
the bracelet onto your
wrist.

Allow the ribbon to hang
low for cool factor
effect!
